<p><u>VS. 6a: George Washington & James Madison</u> What skills did James Madison have that helped the delegates reach agreement during the difficult process of writing the Constitution?</p>	<p>His skills at compromise. Compromise means <u>no one gets everything they want</u>—everyone has to give up something—so that good things can happen.</p>
